

Hosts Liz & fellow cyclist Mike Wigginton served a delicious lunch, so please remember to patronize this great restaurant in downtown Jackson!






Ride of Silence

League of Michigan Bicyclists/Michigan Mountain Biking Alliance

The League of Michigan Bicyclists (LMB) and Michigan Mountain Biking Association (MMBA) are moving forward with a unification to bolster and broaden the voice of the Michigan bicycling community. We recognize that we are all stronger when we work together.

Moving forward, MMBA will become part of the League of Michigan Bicyclists. Through this unification, the MMBA acronym will remain, but the name will change slightly to be the Michigan Mountain Bike Alliance. This retains the well-established MMBA moniker and branding, but also signifies this important organizational shift. As a strategic "Alliance", MMBA will represent a relationship among people and groups who work together for positive change.

Mountain biking is a natural fit with LMB's mission to "improve life through bicycling." This transition will supplement and expand on LMB's current work and extend our reach throughout the bicycling community, while we maintain progress and attention on existing priorities. A LMB/MMBA unification fits multiple focus areas from LMB's strategic plan, including plans to "strengthen collaborative partnerships with local trail groups," "integrate mountain biking clinics into our educational curriculum," and "plan and implement a membership drive drawing from all types of cyclists."

"LMB has a top-notch organizational structure in place and has done a fantastic job over the past decade advocating for cyclists on our roadways, creating real change, which has enhanced both the rights and safety of cyclists. The MMBA has a long history of securing access to quality trails for off road cyclists. Unifying advocacy efforts for the mutual benefit of Michigan cyclists – road and trail – under one umbrella just makes sense and stands to strengthen the voice of the entire cycling community in our state." – *Jason Aric Jones, Advocacy Director, MMBA, Oct 18, 2022*
