### Club Rides Are Back!

We have waited, and waited, and waited some more. Now that it looks like the nicer spring weather is about to return, we have begun adding our weekly club rides to the Ride Calendar on our website. Below is a summary of the rides we are planning for you this year.

On Two Wheels Sunday Morning Breakfast Ride: Join Adam Kohn Sundays for this 9:00 a.m. ride. Look for this ride to begin sometime in May from the Paragon Academy parking lot at 3750 McCain Road.


On Two Wheels Monday Evening Mountain Bike Ride: Join Pat Sowle for this very popular ride, which is scheduled to begin June 5 at 5:30 p.m. Meet up in the Hurst Planetarium parking lot in Ella Sharp Park.

Tuesday Morning Gravel: Join Ron Utter at 11:00 a.m. Tuesdays for 30 - 35 miles of very low traffic gravel road riding in Jackson and Washtenaw counties. The starting point will alternate weekly between Mt. Hope & Glenn and the Fishville Road locations, so be sure to check the Ride Calendar before heading out to this ride.

Wednesday Evening Road Ride: Join Rick & Cindy Acker at 6:00 p.m. May 10 in the north end of the parking lot of Acapulco Mexican Grill on Clinton Road. This ride will average 16 mph for 24 miles or so, but it is also a "No Drop Ride", so don't be shy, give this ride a try!

Thursday Evening Gravel Ride: Join Ron Utter at 6:00 p.m. Thursday May 4 for a shorter version of his Tuesday morning gravel rides. The starting point for this ride will alternate weekly between Mt. Hope & Glenn and the Fishville Road locations, so be sure to check the Ride Calendar before heading out to this ride. This is a "No Drop" ride.

Saturday Morning Ride: Join Dan McClure at 9:00 a.m. Saturday May 6 for a Mike Levine Lakelands Trail ride to Stockbridge. This ride will start at the Hawkins Road trailhead at 9:00 a.m., or you could meet the group in Munith at about 9:30 a.m. This is a "No Drop" ride.




## Ride of Silence

May 17, 2023



This ride aims to raise the awareness of motorists, police and city officials of cyclists' legal right to use public roadways. The ride is also an opportunity to show respect for and honor the lives of cyclists who have been injured or killed while cycling. All cyclists are invited to join the members of the Cascades Cycling Club for this solemn, silent ride. Please plan to join us for this event.

This year we will be riding in honor of Linda Porter, who was killed by a hit and run driver while riding on Park Road. We knew Linda as an avid cyclist, kayaker and dog walker who was a familiar face on the Falling Waters Trail. Reading Linda's obituary gave me a sense of just how many lives she had touched, and that Linda will be missed by many. Club member Shelly Wilson is preparing a Ghost Bike in Linda's memory which will be placed on Park Road.

Please join us at 6:45 p.m. on May 17 as we line up for this ride at Horace Blackman park in downtown Jackson.


